
INTEGRATED LEARNING MODEL

USING THE INTEGRATED LEARNING MODEL

EXAMPLES

"How does this **concept** and **view of people** <u>clarify</u> my **responsibility**?"

"How does biblical **truth** and **research** <u>enhance</u> my ability to deal with **conflict**?

"How does this **experience** <u>conform to</u> **theory** in light of **biblical truth**?"

"How can this Christian **value** or **research** <u>lead to</u> a better **culture** for my **team**?"

"How does this **concept** help <u>explain</u> my past **failure**?"

"How does my environment affect my view of people?"

"How can this **theory** <u>challenge</u> or <u>contradict</u> my **decision-making**?"

"In what ways does this **truth** or **belief** <u>call into question</u> this **theory** and how does that <u>match</u> real-life **experience**?
